## BLS CPR for the Healthcare Provider Skills Sessions

### About Skills Sessions

#### BLS for Healthcare Providers Online part 1

##### On-line training

The Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Providers (HCP) Online Part 1 is completed by going to [www.OnlineAHA.org](http://www.OnlineAHA.org) and completing the BLS for Healthcare Providers Online part 1. Students first complete online lessons through a series of self-paced modules. Students answer short multiple-choice questions within case-based scenarios, and receive feedback based on their answers to proceed through 10 critical checkpoints. To reinforce the CPR sequences taught in the course, students can access 21 optional review sections, including 17 videos from the BLS for Healthcare Providers classroom video. Part 1 can be completed in approximately 1-2 hours.

#### BLS for Healthcare Providers Online part 2 & 3

##### Classroom skills session: practice and testing

A skills session is the hands-on portion of an AHA eLearning course and includes Parts 2 and 3 — skills practice and testing. Once you register with Rescue Training Institute, it is conducted in-person after the student completes Part 1 online. The student will then bring the “Part 1 Completion Certificate” to the skills session. At the session, the student can review their skills on a manikin and then be tested. Parts 2 & 3 can be completed in one hour. Call 916-939-2277 to register for the classroom Skills Sessions.
